

Edward River Council's Rural Tree Planting Scheme allows rural landowners in the Edward River local government area to purchase subsidised indigenous plants.

To be eligible for this scheme you must be a rate payer of Edward River Council and own property larger than one (1) hectare. Ratepayer's orders are capped at the maximum number of subsidised tube seedlings shown below, irrespective of the number of rate notices.

The number of trees available per eligible property per annum are:

One (1) hectare to Ten (10) hectares	50 tube seedlings
Ten (10) hectare to Five Hundred (500) hectares	150 tube seedlings
Five Hundred (500) hectares and over	300 tube seedlings

Orders are to be a minimum of five (5) seedlings per species and in lots of five (5).

Orders must be returned to Edward River Council by the closing date where council staff will check the order forms to confirm ownership and holding size prior to processing payments.

Each year McKindlays Riverine Nursery supplies a list of both native species and non-local native species available for order. See pages 3 and 4 for this year's tree species list.

McKindlays Riverine Nursery may contact you to discuss your order in relation to soil and chosen species type. You are welcome to contact them direct on 0408 641 222 for advice when choosing seedlings.

Order Pickup: You will be contacted in May 2027 advising when your seedlings will be ready for collection.
